

Uniform Reminder

It has been really pleasing to see the majority of students wearing full school uniform. With the colder weather now upon us, it is essential that students are wearing either the school rugby top or jumper and an appropriately coloured T shirt or thermal wear under their polo shirts for extra warmth. Track pants are not permitted unless students are participating in Physical Education.

Students can wear an over jacket, in school colours, whilst outside. Hoodies are not permitted under any circumstances, which include travelling to and from school.

It is important to note that by the start of Term Three, all students are expected to be wearing black, polishable, lace up school shoes or serviceable T bars.
