What type of online services are used at our school?

Our school uses a variety of online services and applications (**online services**) to support and enhance our students' educational experiences and to create a high quality and innovative learning environment. Our school uses online services for:

(May include recordings during periods of remote learning.) Family (parent/guardian) details: 	Compass is a school management and administration software application. It manages student enrolment, monitoring and reporting on their attendance, reporting on academic progress and many other daily tasks that schools must undertake. Compass allows schools to create a profile for each student and keep records associated with that student throughout their time at the school. It also allows the school to communicate with parents and allows parents to access up-to-date information about their child's learning. Teachers can: • track attendance • create and share learning and behaviour plans. • track and analyse assessment and other reportable data, e.g. incidents • view a calendar of events and daily running of events. • use the chronicle function to track student behaviour and health/sickbay incidents. • make use of report design functionality to provide reports and other communications to parents in a consistent format. • upload school timetables and other class activities.
